Installation Instructions

2018+ WRX Front View Monitor T-Harness For use with OEM camera P/N 86357VA010

<u>Step 1:</u> Remove bumper. 3x clips + 6x 10mm bolts under the hood, 1 clip in each wheel well, 9 clips underneath.


<u>Step 2:</u> Locate the gray 13-pin connector above the washer fluid reservoir. Press the locking tab to release & disconnect.

Note: Connector can be removed by releasing the pin holding it in place to make this step easier. A small flathead screwdriver may help with releasing the tab if it's difficult to press or stuck.

<u>Step 3:</u> Plug the 13-pin T-harness connectors into each side of the 13-pin connector.

<u>Step 4:</u> Route the 8-pin connector towards the front of the vehicle. A pickup tool, coat hanger, stiff piece of wire, or long zip tie can help with this.

Note: Be careful to not interfere with existing harnesses or damage the 8-pin connector during this step.



<u>Step 5:</u> Snap the 8-pin connector into place on the front bumper beam.

Tip: Use a wire tie to attach T-harness to the horn wiring to prevent it from moving around. See arrow for location.

<u>Step 6:</u> Tuck the wiring under the foam below the radiator to keep it in place, routing around the ambient temp sensor bracket.

<u>Step 7:</u> Use a wire tie to secure the T-harness to the fog light wiring.

<u>Step 8:</u> Connect your OEM front camera (P/N 86357VA010) to the 8-pin connector.

Note: Slide the black clip onto the bumper beam.



<u>Step 9:</u> Turn vehicle to ON or start engine. Press [Enter] on the MFD to test camera functionality. If image is not displayed, check connectors to make sure they are fully seated, cycle ignition off then back on, and test again.

<u>Step 10:</u> Reinstall bumper. Installation complete!
